## What is so special about Smoke & Fire Curtains Ltd and our products?

## Servery or Hatchway Fire Curtains:

- All made to your specifications.
- Slim, lightweight and easy to install.
- 1 or 4 hour fire resistance.
- Sealed to prevent the passage of fire or smoke.
- All control panels with 24v battery back-up system.

## Gravity Fail Safe & other options:

- Emergency access doorways will use our Gravity Fail Safe motors and panels. This means that even without mains power in the building or if the cables are corrupted or a signal received, then the curtains will close.
- We program the curtain to open up, with an override switch, and then return down to seal the doorway.
- Option of a battery sensor inside the panel which will give an audible/visual signal if the batteries are low.
- Beam sensor units to operate the audible/visual equipment, to indicate stationary items left in the path of the fire curtain.
- Key switches to be used for regular testing of the units.
- Smoke or heat detectors can be provided and prewired into our system.

## Automatic Fire Curtains:

- Single roller systems, up to 6 metres wide, have been certified to BS: 476 Part 22 and have held their integrity for 264 minutes before we turned off the test furnace. 4 hours +10%.
- Fire curtains can provide continuous fire containment in single spans using our overlapping curtains.
- No intermediate supports, columns or centre posts are needed, except at the outside edges.
- Overlapping rollers also have a certified time of 264 minutes at 1000 degrees Celsius.
- Option of split drop or delay functions can provide more time to escape and are therefore a part of the critical life safety requirement. Split drop also provides progressive smoke containment.
- Control Panels are necessary to control the motors and co-ordinate all the functions of the system and to relate to the client's fire/smoke alarm system.
- Key switches are provided to test the curtains on a regular basis.
- Curtains tested to various British & European standards. Please enquire for an up to date list.

## SmokeSafe – Automatic & Static Smoke Curtains:

- The smoke curtains are manufactured from our 1 hour fire curtain material.
- They can be either statically fixed or automatically controlled.
- The smoke curtains could be installed without side guides as a tolerance is allowed around the edges, through which a small amount of smoke may seep. This seepage allowance is subject to local fire regulations.
- The method of overlapping one curtain against another is used to cover large expanses.
- The overlapped curtains are retained together with the use of a conjoined bottom rail.

Doorways & Windows Fire Curtains:



- Can have either a standard drive up, drive down panel or a Gravity Fail Safe panel.
- Doorways can have the option of an override switch. Once pressed, these switches retract the curtain to open the space then return the curtain down to seal the doorway.
- The option for a beam sensor also works well on doors. If anyone stops in the doorway and breaks the beam, the curtain will stop immediately. It will then return to the top before starting to descend again.

## Our Products.

## FireSafe 60 – 1 Hour Automatic Fire Curtain:

- Certified to BS: 476 Part 22, tested either at Exova Warrington or at Chiltern Fire test centres.
- Can provide 60 minutes of continuous fire containment.
- Standard drop down systems.
- Split drop delay, gives the option of the curtain dropping in stages. This can provide temporary means of escape and as a smoke containment system.
- Control panels co-ordinate all functions of the curtains.
- Single roller systems, up to 6 metres wide or overlapping rollers to cover and protect larger spans.

## FireSafe 240 – 4 Hour Automatic Fire Curtain:

- Certified to BS EN: 1634, tested at the Exova Warrington test Centre.
- Can provide 264 minutes of continuous fire containment
- Control Panels co-ordinate all functions of the curtain, controlling the motor and relates to the fire alarm system. Override, beam sensors, split drop facility, smoke or heat detectors and the test key switch are via the 24v control panel.
- Standard drop down systems
- Split drop delay gives the option of the dropping in stages. This can provide an extended amount of time to escape and also provides the initial smoke containment.
- Single roller systems, up to 6 metres wide or overlapping rollers, used to span greater widths.

## Both curtains come with these optional additions:

- Gravity fail safe system designed to ensure that even with a total power failure, mains and battery back-up, the curtains will still close down into a protection mode.
- Override switches used as a means of escape. Pressing the switch rolls the curtain back up, allowing people to escape. Once the switch has been released the curtain will once again fall to the floor.
- Audio visual alarms these warn of the curtain about to descend, using a flashing light and/ or audible sound unit.
- Audible/visual alarm to indicate batteries are down to 80% capacity. Also to close if programmed.
- Beam sensors, to open in an emergency or to warn of possible obstructions left in the path of the curtain.

## FireSafe Plus – Insulated Zone Automatic Fire Curtain:

- Fully Certified to BS EN 1634 standard and to PAS 121.
- With 150 minutes fire integrity and 150 minutes insulation zone.\* \*Insulation zone means that people can pass close to the non-fire side, ½ metre away from the curtain itself. This means that that evacuees can leave in relative safety, protected by the conductive properties of the insulated curtain material.
- Smoke seals provided to stop the spread of toxic gasses.
- Override switch to inform the control panel to raise the curtain if in a fire mode.
- Curtain impact tested by swinging a heavy bag of sand against it several times, with operation between strikes.



- The motor passed the fire test when it was operated 5 times inside a furnace at 300 degrees Celsius.
- Curtain and steel framework tested to prove air leakage containment was well above standard.
- Continuous cycle test on a 5m wide x 3m high unit, 760 cycles with mains to the control panel and 60 cycles without mains supply to the control panel.

## Benefits of all of our specially made smoke & fire curtains:

- Made to measure, all non-standard sizes made to within 5mm of your specifications.
- Safer than heavy and dangerous steel roller shutters.
- Visually more attractive as they blend into the building structure.
- Offers far better conductive properties than steel roller shutters.
- Fail safe option available, unlike steel roller shutters.
- Can be lowered daily to conform to local Fire Officer Requirements.
- Slim, lightweight and easy to install.

#### Maintenance:

In order for our products to be in full working order we offer a maintenance service, relieving the owners from the responsibility of ensuring that the units will work when they are really needed. In the program we arrange for all installed curtains to be annually inspected by one of our engineers. A full report on their condition is given in writing. Please ask us for more information on this option.
